October 11 - Tuesday *Depart for Athens, Greece*

Depart your hometown and take an international flight to Athens Greece. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service during your flight.

October 12 - Wednesday *Arrive in Athens | Walking Tour*

Arrive in Athens, Greece for your three-night pre-cruise stay to explore the classic city of Athens and the nearby spiritual sites. Your host will greet you at the airport, and you will be transferred to our city-center hotel. In the afternoon, we will set off from our hotel for a walking tour to see some of the key sights nearby and learn about surrounding neighborhoods that you can wander around during our independent time tomorrow.

Tonight, we enjoy a welcome dinner in the hotel. (Dinner)

OVERNIGHT: Divani Palace Acropolis Hotel, Athens

October 13 - Thursday *Athens | Acropolis*

This morning start the day with Mass in a local church, and then tour the key sites of Athens, with an archaeological walk past landmarks like the Temple of Olympian Zeus, Ancient Agora, Hadrian's Arch, and of course, the Acropolis. We will have a privately guided tour to the top to see the ancient ruins there and hear the stories of history.

Afterwards, enjoy time at leisure. You might want to head to the Central Market for a feast of fresh fruit and veggies, nuts, olives, and Grecian cheese. Or check out a local taverna where you can rub elbows with the locals well into the wee hours of the night. (Breakfast)

OVERNIGHT: Divani Palace Acropolis Hotel, Athens

October 14 - Friday *Day Trip to Corinth*

Travel from Athens to Corinth, with a stop to see the Corinth Canal, which connects the Ionian Sea and Aegean Sea. It was envisioned for 2000 years and was built in the 1800's and first used in 1893.

Tour the city of Corinth, where the apostle Paul traveled to upon his departure from Athens. "He preached the word...and many of the Corinthians who heard believed and were baptized. (Acts 18:5,8). "He settled there for a year and a half and taught the word of God among them (Acts 18:11). Explore the archaeological ruins of ancient Corinth, including the marketplace, baths, temples, and theatre. Stand on the Bema, the site of the apostle Paul's trial, when he was brought for judgement for illegal teachings. We'll celebrate Mass and have lunch before returning to Athens.

The evening is open for you to explore the nearby restaurants from our centrally located hotel. (Breakfast, Lunch)

OVERNIGHT: Divani Palace Acropolis Hotel, Athens

October 15 - Saturday *Embark on Cruise*

You'll have some free time this morning for any shopping you want to do in the shops in the neighborhoods surrounding our hotel, and then we will depart to board our ship. On the way we'll stop at a local church for Mass, before arriving at the port of Piraeus for embarkation.

Once onboard the ship, you are free to choose your own activities, dining preferences, and excursions throughout the cruise. We will have Mass daily in a designated location on the ship, two group dinners, and on Tuesday October 18, we have our included exclusive excursion in Ephesus.

Any other shore excursions in port, besides Ephesus, need to be booked and paid separately. In addition to the cruise line excursions, we will offer a variety of customized excursions available for our group members at an additional cost. In each port destination, you are free to tour independently, choose a ship's excursion, or select one of our group's optional excursions. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

OVERNIGHT: Azamara Quest

October 16 - Sunday *Tinos, Greece*

Known as "The Handmade Island", Tinos exudes authenticity. Its gastronomy scene is highlighted by meals made from local ingredients, and its rugged and untamed landscapes showcase Greece in all her beauty. With plenty to explore and enjoy, its reputation among the Greeks as a hidden gem is well earned. Mass onboard ship. (All meals served onboard)

OVERNIGHT: Azamara Quest

October 17 - Monday *Mykonos, Greece*

Picture perfect is the best way to describe Mykonos. Idyllic in every way, from the brilliant blue water in its harbor to the rows of 16th-century Venetian windmills, Mykonos is a postcard come to life! Spend your days strolling delightful cobblestone streets and visiting artisan craft shops. And when the sun goes down, discover why locals refer to this hedonistic city as the Ibiza of Greece! Mass onboard ship. (All meals served onboard)

OVERNIGHT: Azamara Quest

October 18 - Tuesday *Kusadasi (Ephesus), Turkey*

Today we have an exclusive included excursion for our group to visit the area of Ephesus and all the key sites.

We will visit the House of Virgin Mary. According to Catholic tradition, Mary accompanied John to Ephesus as he spread the Good News. "When Saint John set out to Ephesus, he also took Mary there and from here Blessed Holy Mary was taken up to heaven on wings." (Pope Benedict XV, Good Friday homily on Sacred Mysteries). Mary spent her last years in Ephesus in a small house on Mount Mulbul, which is now a shrine a place of pilgrimage.

Ancient Ephesus will be the next stop, where the archeological sites of the Odeon, Concert Hall, the Library of Celsus and the Grand Theatre where St. Paul preached will be explored. Saint Paul first visited Ephesus during his second missionary journey, and returned on this third journey to say from 53-56 AD. On his later travels Saint Paul wrote his epistle to the Ephesians.

We will also visit the Church of Virgin Mary inside Ephesus and visit the famous Terrace Houses, which are luxurious residential villas dating back to the second century BC. Guests will then enjoy a "Biblical lunch" at a local restaurant, where they will be served food cited in the Bible and dishes made in accordance with Biblical ingredients. After lunch, the tour will then proceed to remains of St. John's Basilica which overlooks Ephesus and was once a great church built on a 2nd century tomb thought to hold the remains of St. John. We'll celebrate Mass in Ephesus before returning to the ship. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

OVERNIGHT: Azamara Quest

October 19 - Wednesday *Rhodes (Lindos), Greece*

First on your agenda should be the Rhodes waterfront where once stood the Colossus of Rhodes, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Just a short ride away, the medieval town of Lindos features houses stacked like giant sugar cubes on a steep hill. Hitch a donkey ride to the acropolis at the top for spectacular views of the town and Saint Paul's Bay. Mass onboard ship. (All meals served onboard)

OVERNIGHT: Azamara Quest

October 20 - Thursday *Agios Niklolaos, Crete*

Known for having "three faces to the sea", this port on Crete's east coast seamlessly blends the charm of a small fishing village with the glamor of a chic resort town. The perfect base for exploring smaller islands around Crete, it's easy to create your own personal paradise in Agios Nikolaos. Mass onboard ship. (All meals served onboard)

OVERNIGHT: Azamara Quest

October 21 - Friday *Santorini, Greece*

The capital, Fira, clings to the rim of the caldera 900 feet above the sea. Take the cable car or giddy up on a donkey to climb the 588 steps to the top. Hike to nearby Oia, a quintessential Greek village. Head south to the 3,500-year-old Minoan town Akrotiri. Often called Greece's answer to Pompeii, the well-preserved ruins provide a glimpse into Santorini's storied (and explosive) past. Mass onboard ship. (All meals served onboard)

OVERNIGHT: Azamara Quest

October 22 - Saturday *Piraeus (Athens), Greece*

End your journey in Piraeus. We'll have an included transfer to the Athens airport for your return flight home. (Breakfast)

Reservations and Deposits: All prices are in U.S. Dollars, and based on double occupancy.
